

Minutes of the Caust Place Farm

Minutes of the last meeting read and
proposed as a true record by Mr Joames
seconded by Mr G Smith and vote
Unanimous.

Matters arising Mr Straud reported that
there was a meeting of the
allotment sub-committee to discuss sheds
and greenhouses on allotments. As minuted
at the last meeting the rent for Mr
Gurneys 10 pole plot had not been
taken.

Secretaries Report

Mr Straud reported large

were selling well and this was

Water supply improvements

Due to Council decision that water supply on allotments was essential the $12\frac{1}{2}\%$ on the cost of improvements, on our ground rent had now been waived.

Mr Webb. asked committee to advise our Secretary on what we think shed and greenhouse sizes should be when he goes to the Estates meeting, in discussion it was felt that $6' \times 8'$ rigid construction would be O.K. for Greenhouses and $6' \times 6'$ for sheds.

Plots

A list of allottees with bad plots had been made, and they had been told about this when the rents had been taken.

Shed application

An application for a shed had been made by Mr Kimber Plot 64 the site for this would be pegged.

Mr Strand reported that a Mr Moore was not a good allottee and should be asked to go as he had not cultivated his plot.

Treasurers report.

The rent account was £257 in the bank and the ground rent to Oxford City Council had

been paid.

General account

We had £472 in the general account. Bills to be paid amounted to £200 so about £272 in the bank. Mr A Smith commented that he found these figures useful to know. Mr Webb asked what shall we do with the £257 in the rent account. Mr Strand thought it best to consolidate the rent account for any site jobs. It was generally felt that the general account was healthy and that we were doing a good job.

Any other Business

Mr Flay enquired if Mr Strand needed any more help in the job of Secretary. Mr Strand said he could do with more help in unloading lorries, but Mr Jandy had been very helpful in the Association affairs. Mr A Smith said he would like it limited the help that Mr Jandy was giving.

Annual General Meeting

If a Y.M. would be on the 30th of November Mr Sheehan would confirm this date with Mr Pervey of the Martimer Hall Theatrical Group who had been kind enough in the past to give up the Hall for this purpose, and report back to the Secretary.

reported that the top field gate needed
attention Mr Webb & Mr Sheehan to
examine.

Mr Smith requested that he give up a
plot and take on a $\frac{1}{2}$ plot. In discussion
it was felt that the vacant half plot be
given to the next one on the list and
Mr Smith put his name on the waiting
list for $\frac{1}{2}$ plot.

meeting closed, the next meeting to be
in Westminster Hall at 7-30 pm on November
7th.
