Matters arising

Date of A.G.M. Mr Shuckham
reported that he had been unable to book

from the supplier.

Secretary's report.

Toilet an estimate for the
work on updating our toilet was awaited
from Mr J Braugh. (Plumber). The Council
will also be asked about toilets, roads,
and Drainage at their meeting.
Main Roadway the main entrance roadway

to the site was in a bad state and contact was being made to Wrosten Parish Council regarding it.

East Boundary It will also be put to the Council that our East Boundary needs digging and ditching and the cost will be in the region of £500-00.

Ballot

A load of this had been delivered for our roadways but a coarser type would have been best.

New Amenity Building

The money was now available from the council for this project. Mr Straud displayed the plan of the Building which would be 16' x 25' and excellent for our needs the Base would soon have to be laid. When the new building is erected we would need an implement shed 8' x 12' we would also need to get rid of the existing small shed and the temporary tin shed. During these changes storing stock would be a problem.

Lining the new Building

Mr Straud suggested that we would have to pay to get this job done at the rate of £1-00 per hour. Mr A Smith suggested that money can come from the Deposit account if the next account runs out of money due to this project, committee agreed with this suggestion.

Tin Shed this would have to be taken

down this would cost us about \$50-00 + \$50-00 to transport it away.

Trees We have six willows to be cut down and we could get the job done for \$10-00 per tree. Mr A Smith proposed that the man he employed to do this be seconded by Mr J Smith and vote unanimous Till.

\$60-00 was needed to purchase this, it was generally felt that it was not needed. Mrs Faulkes offered to get an sewing machine, Mr Straud thought a proper ~~one~~ till was necessary. After discussion it was agreed to leave the matter in abeyance until our new building was commissioned.

Goals.

Forks and Spades salvaged from our fire had been fitted with new handles and sold for \$5-00 each.

Yapsal.

A load of this was by the scout hut and we can have it but it would cost us \$30-00 to move it it was agreed this could go ahead.
