building and increase of £232-00 on these
two items. After discussion regarding future
rents a proposition was made by Mr
J. Smith that rents be increased to
£7-00 per annum per plot £3-50 per plot
Pensioners £6-00 per annum per plot
£3-00 per 1/2 plot. Seconded by Mr
Elliot and vote unanimous. This was
