Chairman's Report

Mr wheable stated that $2\frac{1}{2}$ pole plots were no good as they encouraged "Plot hopping" all agreed. At this point Mr Sheehan, minutes Secretary, reminded committee of a past decision not to size our plots in "Poles" measurement but in Plots and half plots, definition decided by Letting committee.
