

Minutes of the Cayst Place Farm Allotments
Committee meeting held in Mortimer Hall,
old Marston on 18th May 1994 the meeting
commenced at 7-35 p.m.

Chairman's opening remarks.

Mr Wheable reported
that he had received a letter from
Mr Gill Gandy, Thanking committee for the

Minutes of the last meeting

Association Shop

Mr Wheable had delved into
the records and found that this had
started as the show fund and was now
called the General fund Mr Wheable thought
this now needed changing again.

Long standing committee persons stated that
they had never known it called the show
fund in their time Mrs Allen suggested that
a co-op be set up. Mr Weiss said call
it the general purpose account. There was
also the view not to change the name

at all but to keep the name General account. This idea was proposed by Mr Wainey and seconded by Mr Carr and vote unanimous. Mr Sheehan also proposed that before the next Annual general meeting both our accounts, The Rent account, and the general account be professionally audited. This proposal was seconded by Mr Wainey and vote unanimous. A Messrs Halpern and Wolfe were suggested as the auditors to approach to do our accounts.

Proposal from Mr Savin that in the event of the Court Place Farm allotments closing down that an extraordinary general meeting of current allottees be held to decide what to do with the funds of the Association. Seconded by Mr Wainey and vote unanimous.

Associate Membership

It was proposed after discussion that a recommendation to the Annual general meeting for Associate membership for non-allottees be increased from 20/- per annum to 50/- per annum, the fees to be deposited in the general account. This fee would allow the non-allottee to use the shop only. Proposed by Mr Weiss seconded by Mr Wainey and vote unanimous.

Site control and work

Mr Wheable reported that our Hayter mower was getting worn out and suggested a new mower a "Snapper" at £530. Mr Allen enquired from what account the money would come from. This matter would be given some thought by committee and debated again.

Annual General Meeting

We would be informing the membership by letter.

Mrs Robinson wife of Alf Robinson deceased. We would be sending her a cheque to purchase something for her patio as a memorial to Alf. The money to come from the general account.

Mr Mc Carthy his death had been reported to committee. He was a member of the association for some time.

Work on site

Mr Wheable reported that a man was being paid £3.00 per hour for site work should this be increased to £5.00? Mr Messey proposed £4.00 per hour Mr Weiss proposed £5.00 per hour Seconded by Mr Allen Vote 8 for 1 against.

Mr Cann announced that entries were required for Oxford City Council Best Allotment competition.
