Mowers had been viewed by Mr Chapman, Mr Ginder and Mr Strand.

Mr Ginder had viewed a second hand mower for £450.00 + VAT + £300.00 for an overhaul it was 2 year old and there was no guarantee with overhaul 3 month warranty.

Mr Chapman thought rough plots ought to be done by a contractor

Mr Strand thought we ought to take "Bryant's" advice that a tractor type mower was not suitable for allotments and they advised a power driven rotary i.e. a Mountfield

Mr Shukan stated 2 problems plots and paths and plot ploughing seemed out of the question for a tractor type mower attachment. so a power rotary seemed best for the paths.

after a general discussion as to the pros and cons as to what was available.

was debated. a proposal was made by Mr Sriet that we buy a Mountfield M6 5HP, 21" cut seconded by Mr Smith vote
