fixed at 2/- per bag. Decided to sell on Sundays.

On the subject of potatoes. It was decided to

Home Guard. Agreed to order 7. Stock and sell
at 2/6 for 14 lb. and further to order
for main crop. One ton. Imperfect. three tons of
Siran. Bannet, three tons of Great Hot. which would
sell at 1/- a cwt 8/- for 2 cwt 4/- for 25 lb.

Small seeds Decided to hold this over for time being.

Decided not to send Delegate to Cardiff on May 1950.
Proposed Mr. King seconded Mr. Jones that next meeting
be held last Thursday in January 1950.
