Matters arising Stolen Shredder. The loss by theft of this piece of equipment, had been paid in full by our insurance £612-99.

North Boundary Bridge

There had been no action by council to improve this crossing of the right of way, over our North Boundary ditch.

Rubbish Dumping There had been no further complaints from allottees over this matter.

Skip from Council This had been delivered and filled with no problem.

Cutting into main path.

A Mr Chapman had done this. Two committee men to have word about it.

First aid Box We had purchased a "Boots" First aid kit. It had comprehensive contents and would be kept in our Amenity Building.

Bonfires on site guidance notes had been issued to allottees, there seems to be a slight improvement and no complaints from local residents.

Secretary Report.

The competition for the best plots has commenced, this year there are two new judges.

Breakins numerous break-ins had occurred on site and had been reported.

There had been an incident on site between a Mr Rudwell and Mr Stowe over the taking of bean poles. There had been an argument and the Police had been called. However after negotiations between committee men and the allottees concerned a Justice had been called.

Deaths of allottees The Secretary reported the deaths of a Mr Lurham a committee man and a Mr Pullen a long time allottee

a Mr Limbs had complained about a Mr Tyas an adjacent allottee for lack of cultivation and not cutting his path. A verbal approach to Mr Tyas would be made telling him the problem.

Treasurers report.

a proposal from the Treasurer Mr Sandy to close our Barclays Bank account due to the closure of our branch in Cherwell Drive. To open two accounts, The General and the rent, with the Bradford and Bingley Building Society in the names of the association. Three trustees namely

Mr J J Gandy, Mr P Savin, and Mr J Cann with any two of these trustees signatures for withdrawal. Seconded by Mr Sheehan and vote unanimous. A letter would be sent to the Bank to close our accounts. Signatures to be sent to the Bradford & Bingley.

Mr Gandy further reported. That our general account stood at £402-95 p.

Sales to date £4781-21 this time last year £4762-86 an increase this year of £18-35.

Rent account. Balance stands at £483-61

Skip Hire £45-24 to Federation including £10-00 prize money £20-00 Rents received £418-20 Skip hire rents £22-50.

Deposit account. with Bradford and Bingley. £5100-24 p.

Any other Business. Mr Wheelable reported that our building break ins had been with Burglars using Bolt cutters to cut our locks. A new device was on the market to make cutting locks more difficult, and only £2-00 each it was agreed to purchase same.
