

Minutes of General Meeting held at the
British Legion Club Martin's Monday January 28th 1946.

Members present. Mr Morris Mr Malone Mr Bone Mr Jones
Mr Arnold Mr Janner Mr Smith
There were no apologies from absent members.

In the absence of the Vicar Mr H. Jones presided.

Meeting opened at 8 pm.

The minutes of the previous A. S. M. were read and
unanimously agreed by the chairman as correct. In the
proposal of Mr Bone and seconded by Mr Morris
secretary Mr Brown then presented reports of the
Committee in general and financial balance sheet.
Also chairman as to ways and means of attracting more
people to take up allotments both reports were submitted
unanimously. The General Fund showed a balance of
and the Allotment A/C.

The following proposition was put by Mr Bone
and seconded by Mr Malone.

Any vacant plots could be let to members at
half rent (provided there is no waiting list) for
one year only from March to March but if after
12 months he wishes to retain plot full rent would
have to be paid. This ruling must be strictly adhered
to.

Mr Plotter was in good condition & he let all
half rent.

Mr Bone's policy allotments competition to be advertised.

Election of Officers. Due to the poor attendance it was
proposed by Mr Janner and seconded by

Mr Malone that members present act as committee for the ensuing year. Mr Brown proposed that a special meeting be called at the end of February in the Oldman's hut which was seconded by Mr Brown. The secretary Mr Brown felt that if members were not interested in coming to such a special meeting would be gained by calling another meeting. The apathy of the members was gaining ground every year which could not be understood by persons unfamiliar as everything that would be done to help members was done. After further discussion it was agreed to leave the matter of another meeting until the future meeting came.

Secretary reported that seed potatoes and small seeds were ordered and would be available at the end of February. Prices would be dispensed as Mr Brown's that.

It was agreed that Mr Smith be again asked to check books of Association.

Sec. Hon. It was agreed that the Secretary's remuneration be the same as last year.

Thos. Now. It was agreed to appoint the Village Well Committee to see if it would be in favour of again running a Fells Day but practically was left to the Secretary.

There being no other business the Chairman Mr Jones thanked members present for their attendance and the meeting closed at 9.45.
